

The History of PAHRA

In 1986, a few local Human Resources professionals from the larger employers in Prescott area began meeting as an informal group. This group, known as the Prescott Personnel Group, met for several years before disbanding. The group reunited in 1994, expanded membership, and became known as the Prescott Area Human Resources Association (PAHRA).

In September 2002, PAHRA became the sixth chapter of the Society for Human Resources Management (SHRM) in Arizona (AZSHRM).

This affiliation brings a more global perspective to HR issues and provides members with additional resources.

Current membership represents Human Resources practitioners from major businesses and small organizations across Yavapai County. Members are professionals from diverse industries including government, higher education, health care, service, distribution and manufacturing. It is anticipated that membership will continue to grow along with the ever-changing Quad-City community.
